Stray and Unsupervised Pets in the Residential Areas

Bulletin - 8th May 2013

To: All Residents in Company Housing From: HRF via Web Bulletin

We are receiving increasing reports around the prevalence of stray and unsupervised pets, mainly dogs, within the Company's residential areas. While we recognise the need for occupants to own and keep pets, such rights should not be at the expense of the safety and convenience of others, particularly as the breach runs counter to the Occupancy Agreement for the use of company housing that all residents have signed.

For emphasis, the relevant portion of the agreement states that:

"... Pets should be kept under control and not be allowed to cause a nuisance to neighbors."

Accordingly, in the interest of safety, the following regulations and measures will be enforced:

- 1. All pet owners should ensure that their pets are duly vaccinated.
- 2. Appropriate traps shall be set around the camp to catch stray and unsupervised pets.

 Pet owners shall be held liable for any harm that such pets may cause other person(s), which
- 3. includes, but is not limited to, paying all costs associated with any attacks (treatment, medication, etc.)
- 4. Appropriate consequence management may be applied in any case of reported pet harassments.

All pet owners who are on final departure and are leaving such pets behind are reminded to ensure that new homes are secured for them (the pets) before their final departure date. In the absence of this, HML/42 should be contacted for further advice.

It is important to note that the Law of Brunei includes a requirement that all dogs are also to be collared with label or badge. A penalty/ fine of \$250 becomes applicable to owners without such label or badge. In addition, any dog found at large without such label or badge may also be destroyed or impounded by (relevant) local authorities. Consequently, any dog owner in breach of this section is also liable to a fine of \$100 or in default imprisonment for 14 days.

On a general note and while we recognise the efforts of most housing occupants to promote and safeguard the interest of others, we solicit the co-operation of all others to comply with laid down regulations, particularly as it relates to this issue of stray and unsupervised pets.

Residents of Company housing are requested to bring this information to the attention of their spouse, children and amahs.




