

Vietuam Travelogue

An Inspiring and Magical Black Hmong Lady, Ly Thi Mu

Ly Thi Mu (aka Mu) grew up in a patriarchal society in the mountainous terrain of Vietnam, where girls are not encouraged to go to school but are expected to provide care to the family, raising younger siblings and performing regular household tasks including cooking, feeding livestock, and laundry. Mu performed the expected role during the 9 years of her childhood. Mu is the fourth of six siblings, which is considered a small family in her home village of Lao Cai. The Lao Cai village has five indigenous Vietnamese tribes, namely the Black Hmong, the Red Chao, the Green Zai (ta ban), the Safo (4 days trekking), and the Day.

Traditionally, Hmong parents arrange for their children's marriage when their children turn 14 or 15 years old. The young wife will begin the routine of pregnancy and continue helping in the family business of farming. Mu, who has no educational background at all, chose to do the unconventional thing, which was to work with a travel agency at 13 years old, where she led groups of tourists trekking into the Lao Cai and Sapa mountains. She made use of this opportunity to sell souvenirs to tourists and at the same time started learning English by talking to her clients. Impressively, she learned word by word from tourists and eventually managed to construct fluent English sentences. Let's not forget, Mu did not even have the background of Vietnamese language before she started learning English!

Refusing to bow to the tribe's culture of arranged marriage was one of Mu's bravest acts to fight for her own future. About 7 or 8 years into her career as trekking guide, Mu realized that reading and writing would open a new chapter of her life. She then decided to start learning reading and writing in both Vietnamese and English at the same time, by seeking guidance and assistance and making use of today's technologically advanced smartphone apps. When we met Mu on our Sapa trekking tour, she had just turned 29 years old and was married to a Dutch journalist. Mu could speak freely in fluent English with us about the Lao Cai local cultural practices, the magical spells used by the Hmong ancestors, Vietnamese communist history, and Vietnam's transformation in recent decades. As of this year, this magical mountain girl had been running her own travel agency with a staff of four for over 3 years, and the company has a very modern and advanced website that is actively searched by overseas tourists. We strongly

believe this is not the end of Mu's achievement. She is still young and energetic. She has a full passion for life. From our conversation, we learned that Mu is currently preparing for her next career in fashion design. She wants to blend her village's culture into the modern world of fashion. We are hopeful to see the next successful chapter in Mu's life.



Living in Borneo, you have probably heard of a local delicacy named Sarawak Laksa.

It was our pleasure at Outpost Brunei-Seria to have a local Bornean, Jacquelin, host a Sarawak Laksa cooking class on 23rd Jan.

We Southeast Asians love complex flavors. We mix the taste of sweet, sour, savory, and to a certain extent bitterness in our food, but we blend them harmoniously to achieve a fragrant and delicious delicacy. Sarawak Laksa fits very well into this category. It has the freshness of prawns, the sweetness of palm sugar, the spiciness of ground chili, and the sourness of lime. The slightly bitter taste of coriander as a topping is a perfect complement to the noodles and gravy.

The cooking class was fully booked with 10 participants. It was not purely learning the cooking. The Outpost Focal Point took the opportunity to introduce a variety of Laksa available within this region. The class lasted 2 hours and towards the end, everyone got the chance to taste the "product" and share with others.


